



## FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

The annual Spokane Foxes Pumas FC club fee covers a variety of services your player receives as a member of the Club. This includes, but is not limited to, US Club registration fee, field rental fees, referee fees, Association fees, and several other daily operating expenses. Spokane Foxes Pumas FC provides families the opportunity to pay in full or commit to our six to eight-month payment plan (select option when registering online). With this commitment you understand that you are obligated to make the required payments and that failure to comply may lead to your player being placed in bad standing, their player card pulled and your account being turned over for collections. Refer to the Spokane Foxes Pumas FC Operating Procedures for further details on the club's policies.

Transferring or leaving the Club - Prior to June players leaving the club may be refunded a percentage of their paid fees. After June 1st, there will be no refunds and players will not be released from Spokane Foxes Pumas FC unless all club fees are paid in full and team fees are up to date at the time of the request. Players with a season ending injury may be eligible for a refund or credit with the amount to be determined on a case-by-case basis. Requests for releases and withdrawals must be presented in writing to registrar@spokanefoxespumasfc.com.

### **Spokane Foxes Pumas FC Team Fee:**

Each team sets an annual estimated budget to cover coaching fees, tournament fees, uniform and equipment fees, and other team related expenses. By joining the team you are committing to the budget and payment plan as it is set forth at the first team meeting. You also agree that the team fees are estimated and will be adjusted throughout the season based on actual costs. By signing this document, you understand that your fees may be adjusted and that you are obligated to pay these fees in full. Failure to meet your team financial obligation may lead to your player being put in bad standing, their player card pulled and the account being turned over to collections.
